Design Notes:

- The materials were chosen for low maintenance and longevity.
- Window placement occurs to maximize views of the Puget Sound and for airflow.
- The butterfly roof and high spaces allow the maximum amount of light to enter the interior during the winter months.
- The three-foot overhang protects the exterior walls from rain and shades the interior from the summer sun.
- This roof and window design act together in combination to circulate the summer heat out to the exterior through the upper windows.
- This results in cooler air entering through the lower windows.
